




## The RPT Convention is Coming Up!


### THE CONVENTION PROCESS:

At the Precinct Convention, McLennan County activists meet within their precincts to conduct convention business and, most importantly, to submit RESOLUTIONS.

Resolutions serve as expressions of the party's positions, goals and directives on a variety of issues. Resolutions are first submitted at the Precinct Convention, then reviewed/approved at the County Convention, then passed to SREC Committees in review for the RPT State Convention. At the State Convention, Resolutions may become part of the Party Platform and Legislative Priorities. YOU vote to determine the platform and priorities!
